### MINUTES OF THE ONE HUNDRED & SIXTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT PUDSEY CONGS C.C. ON THURSDAY 13<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2008

Minutes of 105<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting 15<sup>th</sup> November 2007 – Proposed Lightcliffe, Seconded Umpires Association as an accurate record, subject to addition of Honoraria, and approved by all present.

Matters Arising – There were no matters arising.

Register – All 25 clubs represented.

To Receive Annual Report – Previously circulated via web-site, copies to be available for those requiring a copy. Received by all present after Proposed by Manningham Mills, Seconded Pudsey Congs.

To Receive the Hon. Treasurer's Report and Statement of Accounts – Proposed Woodlands, Seconded Baildon that both the report and accounts be approved subject to verification by the Auditor.

Chairman thanked D. Young for his most diligent handling of the accounts.

To Vote Upon Proposed Alterations To Rules – 8 proposals were voted on with 5 being defeated. Those carried being – Rule 15 The method of transmitting results of all matches will be determined each year by the Management Board and notified to clubs prior to the start of each season. The punishment for non compliance will also be set at the same time.

Rule 35 – After paragraph 6, last sentence to read – A match cannot commence if more than 60 overs have been lost due to adverse weather conditions. Subsequently paragraph 7 to read – providing that a minimum of 40 overs are available etc.

New Rule – The playing conditions in the Cup & Shield Competitions shall be determined by the Management Board & circulated annually to clubs.

2 Directives appertaining to Sponsors and Reproduction of Pictures and Articles will appear in the handbook and must be strictly adhered to.

To Elect League Officials for 2009/2010 – Nominations received all nominating existing Officials. A ballot was not required as all Officials re-elected en-bloc.

Certificates – The President presented certificates to the Championship Winners together with the Cup/Shield Winners.

Any Other Business (at the discretion of the Chairman) –

The Chairman wished Esholt every success on their move to pastures new, they have enhanced the League over the past 10 years and will be greatly missed. They will continue to promote cricket within the local area with the merger with Tong Park, and one of their Officials will continue as League Treasurer.

Honoraria – Proposed Chairman Seconded Pudsey Congs that Honoraria remains the same.

Chairman announced that JCT600 had agreed to Sponsor the League for a further 2 years, and Sovereign Healthcare to continue to Sponsor Cup / Shield. He added that we are lucky to have support of such esteemed companies and thanked them for their continued support.

The Chairman thanked fellow Officials and Members of the Management Board, special thanks to A. Birkinshaw and M. Baker for their work on the web-site, thanks to the President K.H. Moss for his help and support, thanks also to the Media, Press and Bradford Community Radio.
