Chief Executive's report

For at least the past 53 years the Annual Report has been presented in booklet form. With the advance of modern technology times have changed.

Already League tables, averages, individual performances, results of all matches together with detailed accounts of the Sovereign Health Care Priestley Cup & Shield Finals have been published on the web-site.

The publication of the 2009 handbook will no doubt contain most of the above facts and figures therefore repetition at this stage is not really necessary.

SUMMARY

The 2008 season, due mainly to bad weather conditions, proved frustrating for players, clubs and League Officials from start to finish. The current points system continued to assist in providing interesting and competitive matches with issues only being settled on the final day. Any other proposals would have seen the season over at least two weeks earlier, leaving clubs with nothing to play for in the final stages.

The Sovereign Health Care Priestley Cup and Shield competitions suffered from inclement weather all the way through, resulting in both Finals being played on the last possible dates. Following requests from clubs to review the situation, regarding having to trail back on consecutive evenings, the Board are reviewing the playing conditions ready for presentation to the clubs.

The game itself changes very little and there is no point in making changes just for the sake of matters which do not suit a particular club.

Changes are hopefully for improvement and as technology advances so should administrative methods. A vast improvement can be made on the presentation of Match Report Sheets. An experiment carried out this season has shown what can be achieved by electronic processes. Do not be put off or frightened, assistance is available with help at hand - your cooperation is required for everyone to move with the times.

Members of the Board together with some scorers are currently examining scoring by computer and details will be published as soon as possible.

From the beginning of the season our League and many other Leagues have been awaiting directions from the ECB regarding the new legislation for the engagement of overseas players, now known as the 'Managed Migration System'

Although communication between immigration personnel and all Leagues on this subject has been first class there is still no official word from ECB.

The new system is outlined in the October newsletter of the YCB. There is a complete "tightening up" of the procedures, with the emphasis being placed on control by the club. The Board endorses the YCB information and again will ensure clubs are informed of any developments as they occur. It has also been stated that the consequences of not complying with the requirements laid down may be classed as a criminal offence.

Sadly, the League can confirm that we will be one club short in Division 1 – 1st & 2nd team sections next season. The merger with another club by Esholt, has become necessary, in order that cricket survives as a sport in future years. We thank Esholt most sincerely for their participation and contributions over the past seasons and wish them every success in their new venture.

The constitution of the League cannot be determined until an EGM has taken place prior to this year's Annual General Meeting. The outcome of this meeting has therefore delayed the compilation of the fixture programme for 2009. As soon as this is completed all clubs will be notified and details will appear on our website.

Finally, thank you, to all League Officials for their work this past season and to all clubs and their members for the support and cooperation received throughout the year.

First teams review 2008.

The race for the JCT 600 Bradford League Division One title was one of the hottest for years. Woodlands eventually retained the title for a fourth successive season but they were pushed all the way by Pudsey Congs who finished two points behind them. Woodlands will now be looking to equal the record of five successive championships shared by Windhill (1937-1941) and Pudsey Congs (2000-2004) during the 2009 season. Unlike 2007 when they went through the season unbeaten, Woodlands were beaten three times by Cleckheaton twice and Baildon.

The great strength of the Woodlands side was their ability to win close matches. Their bowling attack repeatedly got them out of trouble in a summer when their batting proved to be extremely fragile.

Pieter Swanepoel was the top wicket-taker in the league with 71 wickets and was well supported by Safraz Ahmed (52) and Chris Brice (38). Left arm spinner Brice also topped the bowling averages one year after winning the batting averages.

Pudsey Congs recovered remarkably after losing their first three matches. Their new spin bowling combination of Jeremy Batty (49) and Glen Roberts (34) shared 83 wickets and contributed greatly to their team's success while Babar Butt (641), Andrew Bairstow (596) and Matthew Doidge (428) were the main runscoreers.

East Bierley, Baildon, Bradford & Bingley – who won their first seven games – and Cleckheaton all looked like being title contenders at the halfway point in the season but a lack of consistency in the second half of the campaign cost them dearly.

At the bottom Bowling Old Lane and Brighouse occupied the relegation positions.

Brighouse failed to win a single match and picked up just 23 points – easily the lowest total achieved by any team since the new points system was introduced in 2006.

Old Lane's two-season spell in the top flight came to an end as they finished 24 points adrift of Saltaire.

Farsley and Gomersal will be taking the places of Old Lane and Brighouse in Division One. Farsley, relegated in 2007, took the title under the guidance of their impressive 20-year-old wicketkeeper-batsman David Syers. He clearly relished the responsibility thrust on his young shoulders as he topped the wicketkeeping charts and finished third in the batting averages.

Farsley introduced an exciting new West Indian all-rounder to the league in Lorenzo Inghram. The Jamaican made 643 runs, took 30 wickets and his fine fielding was acknowledged as he won the Division Two fielding trophy.

Gomersal built their success around their strong batting. Opener Richard Gould made 1,108 runs in 19 innings – the second time he has scored 1,000 league runs in a season. He made 1,133 in 25 innings for East Bierley in 2003. Overseas player Kashif Naveed (644) and Bradley Parker (459) also made telling contributions to their team's success. Idle, Keighley and Undercliffe all challenged for promotion but ultimately fell short. Morley and Hartshead Moor finished in the bottom two places and had to apply for re-election.

During the campaign Undercliffe's Mark Gilliver (14,888) and Keighley's Richard Robinson (14,821) overtook Woodlands' Murphy Walwyn (14,733) as the league's all-time leading scorer.

Second Teams review 2008

For the second successive season East Bierley dominated second team cricket by achieving the league and cup double for the second successive year.

They went through the campaign unbeaten and thoroughly deserved the honours which came their way.

The East Bierley side proved itself to have strength in depth in both batting and bowling. The addition of Steve Simpson and Thomas Owens, two players with considerable first team experience, was crucial to their dominance. Simpson made 766 runs and Owens (458).

Skipper Matthew Anderson won the bowling averages after taking 51 wickets with his off spin, while opening bowler Chris Brook was the top wicket-taker with 53.

East Bierley gained 363 points and finished 58 ahead of Esholt whose captain David Dawson – a former East Bierley player – topped the league batting averages.

Cleckheaton's 17-year-old all-rounder Marcus Walmsley had a fine season. He was made more runs than anybody else, 803 and took 52 wickets for good measure.

At the bottom, Spen Victoria, promoted in 2007, and Lightcliffe, runners-up last year, were relegated.

The Division Two promotion race was close fought with just seven points covering the top three. Morley took the title for the first time with Undercliffe being promoted with them. Bradford & Bingley missed out by just a single point.

Brighouse finished bottom but their batsman Jamie Thrush topped the batting averages after scoring 422 runs. Undercliffe veteran Andy Wilsdon headed the bowling averages.

Sovereign Health Care Priestley Cup Final 2008
Pudsey Congs v Woodlands at Wagon Lane, Bingley, September 14

Andrew Bairstow hit a brilliant 121 as Pudsey Congs won the Sovereign Health Care Priestley Cup for the fifth time in seven seasons.

Their margin of victory over the newly-crowned JCT 600 Bradford League champions Woodlands was 51 runs but bare figures alone did not convey the comprehensive nature of Congs's win.

The champions were outplayed in all areas of the game by the side that finished just two points behind them in the title race.

And as Congs savour their third final success over Woodlands in five seasons and their fifth cup triumph in seven seasons the man they will thank is Bairstow.

He is one of the most popular and talented players in the JCT 600 Bradford League and today he played an innings which will live long in the memories of all who witnessed it.

The left-hander arrived at the crease with his side in some disarray at 12-3 after being put in to bat. Former Yorkshire seamer Pieter Swanepoel had removed Alexis Twigg, Adam Patel and Andrew Bourke in quick succession, but Bairstow was in no mood to surrender.

He pulled his first ball from Swanepoel over mid-wicket for six and that set the tone for a wonderful innings.

Five more sixes and 12 fours flowed from his bat in a 131-ball innings which was the fifth-highest score ever made in a Priestley Cup final.

Thanks to Bairstow and fellow left hander Glenn Roberts who made 55 not out off 59 balls, Congs posted a score of 232-7 which was far in excess of all expectations on a Bingley ground which was under water just five days earlier.

Woodlands, normally so disciplined, gave a ragged bowling display which saw them send down 29 wides. All of their bowlers struggled bowling to the left handers. Much has been made of the importance of Swanepoel and Safraz Ahmed to Woodlands' title successes but it was clear in this match that their success has left the back up bowlers short of overs.

The ten over restriction in the cup limits their effectiveness - they can bowl 15 overs each in the league - and Congs certainly cashed in when the opening bowlers were out of the attack.

The 20 overs from Swanepoel (3-34) and Safraz (0-20) yielded 54 runs, but the remaining 30 overs from Tosh Baker (1-35), Richard Spittlehouse (0-56) and Chris Brice (2-80) cost their side 171 runs.

Seldom have the Woodlands bowlers been as careless as they were in this match. They sent down an unforgivable total of 29 wides which contributed to them taking a pedestrian 3hrs 40mins to bowl their 50 overs.

Pudsey Congs were far more controlled and sent down just eight wides. Their bowlers maintained tight control of length and line which meant Woodlands never looked likely to win the game.

Former Yorkshire off spinner Jeremy Batty took three for 29 and Mark Bray - securing his seventh win in seven finals - with two for 37 helped bowl out the champions for 181.

Woodlands' skipper Tim Orrell played a fine innings of 52 before he was well caught by Bray on the mid-wicket boundary off the bowling of left arm spinner Glenn Roberts. Tosh Baker (39) was the only other batsman to make an impression.

Bairstow crowned a fine individual performance by taking three catches behind the stumps. He was deservedly named man of the match by adjudicator Reg Nelson, and in years to come it is likely that this will be remembered as Bairstow's final by all who were privileged to witness a performance that brought a difficult season to a wonderful conclusion.

Even more fitting was the fact that the smile should be put back on the face of Bradford League cricket by a player who always plays with a smile on his - Andrew Bairstow.

Sovereign Health Care Priestley Shield Final Cleckheaton v East Bierley Saturday, September 20 at Moorend.

East Bierley underlined their domination of second team cricket by completing a hat-trick of Sovereign Health Care Priestley Shield wins with a seven-wicket triumph over Cleckheaton at sun-soaked Moorend. They also sealed their second successive Seconds Teams Division One championship and Shield double. And the East Bierley club now have the distinction of being the first in the 105-year history of Bradford League cricket to secure a hat-trick of Priestley Cup wins (1998-2000) and Priestley Shield wins (2006-2008).

This latest triumph, Bierley's fourth in the last five seasons, was secured with a powerful batting performance in a match which provided a fitting climax to a difficult season. It wasn't just the sun that shone at Moorend. The batsmen also turned up the heat as they made the most of a reliable batting surface. The final produced two excellent centuries from Cleckheaton's talented 17-year-old Marcus Walmsley and East Bierley's opener Steve Simpson.

The players were fortunate to experience a wicket of true bounce and good weather on the final day of the campaign.

Cleckheaton, appearing in their first final, were asked to bat first and suffered an immediate setback when Chris Dobson was caught at slip by Steve Simpson in Chris Brook's opening over.

There were genuine fears that Cleckheaton would struggle, but 17-year-old Marcus Walmsley and Rhys Jowett had other ideas as they shared a stand of 67. They played with good sense until Jowett was bowled by East Bierley skipper Matthew Anderson during a controlled spell of off spin which brought him figures of one for 27.

Dean Worrall was trapped lbw by John Glover without scoring and that brought in Edward Walmsley to join his twin brother. Together they gradually quickened the tempo in a stand of 80 which took the score to 148 before Edward departed when he skied a catch to Paul Ellis off Dan Abbott's bowling.

Marcus Walmsley went on to complete a splendid century which contained a six and 17 fours, but was dismissed on 101 to the disappointment of his colleagues. He tried to hit Paul Ellis over the top and was caught in the deep by Glover.

Cleckheaton needed Walmsley to bat out the 50 overs if they were to post a score of 240-250 which was what was needed on such a true pitch. His departure enabled East Bierley to take control.

Despite the efforts of Russell Noble (41), Cleckheaton were eventually dismissed in the final over for 212. Craig Blackburn, Andy Porritt and skipper Neil Shackleton all holed out trying to force the tempo, while two run outs brought the innings to a close.

Noble was dismissed attempting a second run while wicketkeeper Chris Dyer and last man Fraser Green got in a tangle and both finished at the same end.

Chris Brook was the most successful East Bierley bowler with three for 29 while Anderson (1-27) was the most economical on an afternoon when his side didn't bowl with their usual control or accuracy.

East Bierley, who were without Arron Brook who was in Prague on a stag weekend, promoted teenage wicketkeeper Liam Walsh to open with the prolific Steve Simpson.

Walsh only made nine but he did his job as he shared an opening stand of 51 with Simpson who was quickly into his stride.

Simpson had one lucky let off when, having made 19 out of 23, he was dropped by wicketkeeper Chris Dyer who couldn't hang on to a low diving catch when the batsman edged a ball from Marcus Walmsley. Simpson made the most of that escape. He was also reprieved on 58 when Cleckheaton skipper Neil Shackleton dropped the chance at mid on.

After that he made Cleckheaton suffer with as he went on to make 106 with three sixes and 12 fours before being caught low down in the deep by Jowett off the bowling of Porritt. He and Owens put on 106 for the second wicket.
