

Total Cricket Scorer End of Game Procedure

Once the game has finished you need to follow the following procedure:

- 1 Make sure you enter the points for each team
- 2 Highlight any outstanding feature of the game in the notes box
- 5 Click the Tools menu at the top of the screen then Click **UPDATE SCORE**. This is important as it updates the Live Scores website.

Check the league website to make sure it is showing the result of your game

5 The Bradford CL scorecard and game file must be emailed to results@bradfordcl.com immediately after the end of the game..

To do this, follow the procedure below:

Click on the Match tab (top right)

Look for a button that says Reports and click the arrow beneath it then click Print Scoresheet and you will see this screen.

Click on Print

Select Cute PDF Writer as your printer and click Print

When the next box appears you need to decide where to save the print, we suggest the Desktop for ease and you need to name the match

You will need to type in a name in the box we suggest Bradford&Bingley_v_Farsley for example

Click save and that's all the printing done. You can click on Close

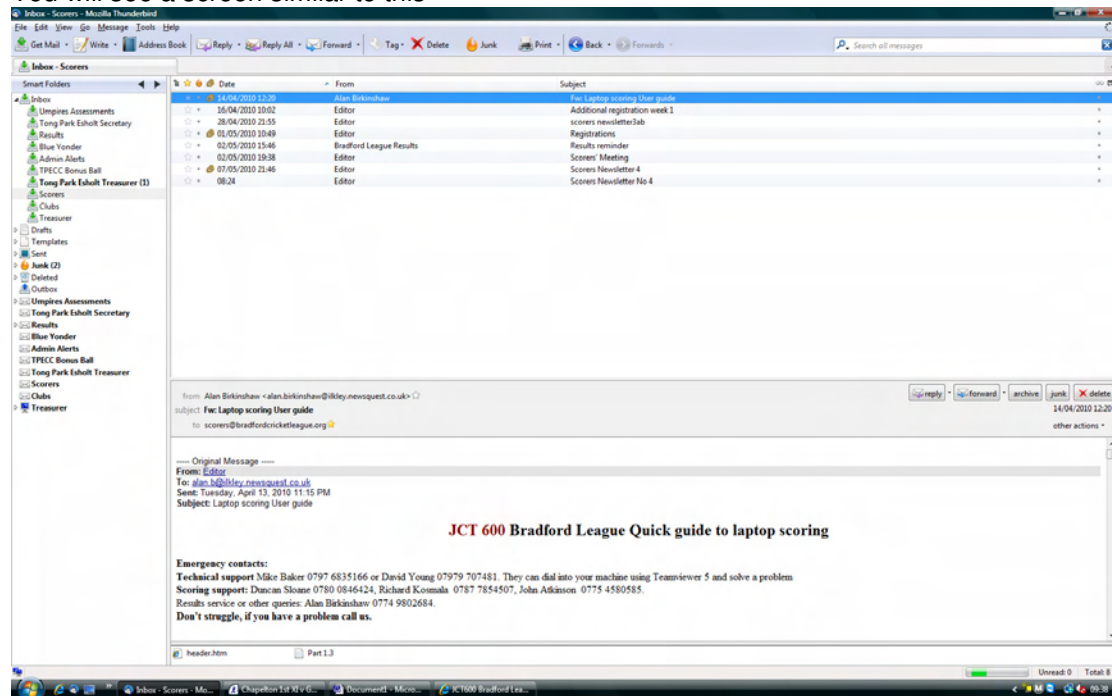
Now, still on the match tab click Export match

You need to save this in the same place as your print out from above. The file will be named automatically for you.

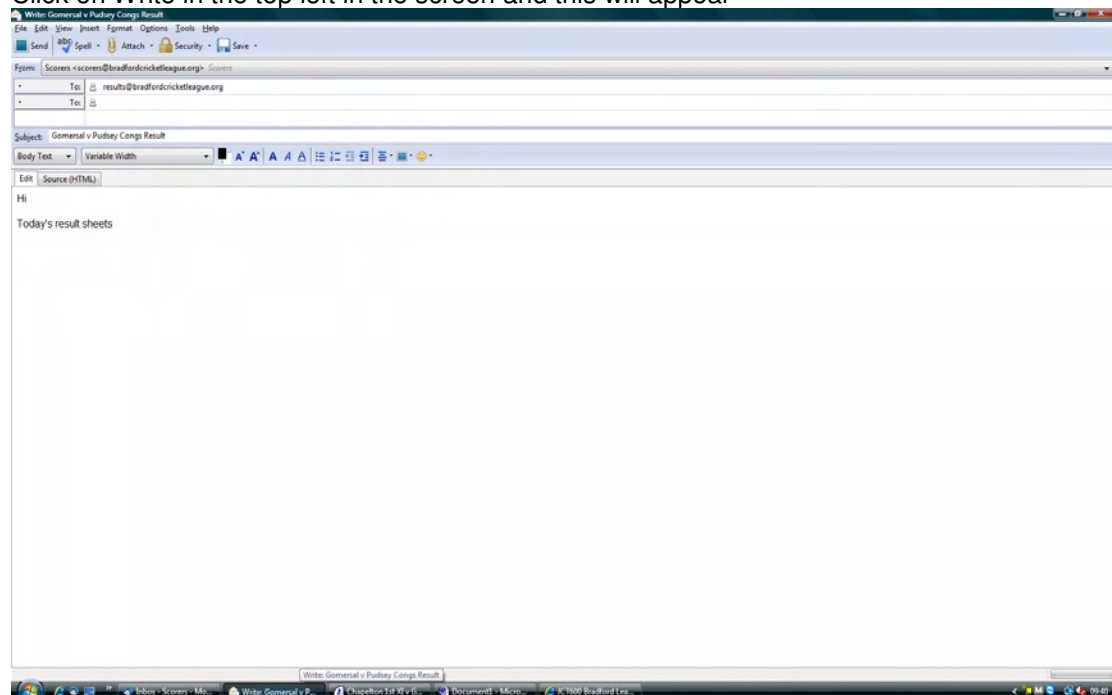
Click Save

You now need to E mail the scoresheet and match data to us.

Open your E Mail program, Mozilla Thunderbird by double clicking the icon on the desktop
You will see a screen similar to this



Click on Write in the top left in the screen and this will appear



You need to type results@bradfordcl.com in the To box and The fixture details such as Bradford & Bingley v Farsley Result in the subject box.

Then click the attach button located at the top of the screen.
You now need to find the scoresheet and match data that you created earlier.
Click desktop and move down the list until you find the scoresheet. Double click on it and it will be attached to the email
Repeat this for the match data which will be in the format of Bradford & Bingley 1stXI v Farsley 1stXI.xml

Then click Send at the top left of the screen.
Wait for the e mail to be sent and you can then exit your e mail program.
You are now done so you can close down your computer
