#### **“Credit Crunch”**

In view of the current situation and in order to assist clubs, the following three ideas were discussed and agreed :-

Payment for Dinner tickets would not be included in the pre season invoice.

For the 2010 season the League would examine the possibility of a bulk purchase of cricket balls which would again help clubs in saving funds.

An option to distribute Cup & Shield prize money amongst all clubs would be considered In consultation with the sponsor.

#### **Charity Donation**

Proceeds from collections at the Cup & Shield Finals would be allocated to the Benevolent Fund.

#### **Outstanding Payments**

Both Manningham Mills and Woodlands had outstanding payments to the League.

It was agreed that both clubs should be written to and given a final date for payment .Both clubs would also be warned that failure to comply by the fixed date would lead to more strict and serious action being taken.

#### **Correspondence**

Brighouse – Information received re conflict with Northowram C.C. This was a matter between the two clubs.

East Bierley – Notice of their club Twenty/20 competition . Board wished them every success with reminder that League commitments take preference at all times.

#### **Club Representative to Board**

Undercliffe - Nominated Mr Z Hussain to fill the vacant position. The Board co-opted Mr Hussain for the 2009 season.

**Appeal**

Manningham Mills – An appeal against an earlier decision re non acceptance of registration of Bilal Ejaz. The player had contravened YCB transfer regulations on three occasions. It was unanimously agreed that the previous decision would stand.

**Promotion/Relegation/Constitution**

After a lengthy discussion it was agreed that unless circumstances alter, the current position would remain. Promotion/relegation for 2009 would be 2 up,2 down. A statement would be issued on our website that the League would seek new clubs to enhance the League.

**League Trophies**

The Treasurer and Chief Executive would meet with a trophy supplier with regard to the overall supply, safe keeping, cleaning etc of all trophies after difficulties had been encountered with our current supplier.

**Facilities/Pitch Marking**

Progress continued to be made thanks to the efforts of Mr. R Heyhoe and the IOG. Further news would be relayed to clubs as and when events occur.

**ECB Junior Player Regulations.**

ECB regulation regarding “no player under-13 allowed to play in senior cricket” would be incorporated into existing league rules.

**Club Chairmen**

Following the recent successful meeting it was agreed that at least two such meetings should be held each season.

The President would attend League Cricket Conference and Chief Executive deal with County Club matters.
